#### Introduction to the activity: digital tools

**Learning objectives:** After completing this worksheet, you will be able to get to know some digital tools that can help in the creation of success stories and choose which of them you can use with your students

**Duration of the activity:** 1 hour

**Short description of the activity:** There are various digital tools and software that can be used in the creation of success stories and facilitate working with students, as well as giving them basic notions of using digital in the creative process. These can be divided into storyboard tools, presentation software and illustration creators. This activity provides a list of usable tools divided into categories.

**Step 1:** Check out these tools for the creation of the storyboard: these programs have specific functions for organising boxes and adding text descriptions to facilitate the storyboard construction process.
